4. Health and Safety Matters

Health Matters

At our school, we are committed to fostering a safe and healthy environment where every SKLite can thrive. Keeping our community well requires all of us to play our part — caring for ourselves and caring for one another. In this spirit, we seek your support in keeping your child / ward at home when he / she is unwell, so that we can collectively protect the health and well-being of all SKLites.

Temperature-taking is a daily routine at our school, instilling in SKLites the importance of both caring for themselves and caring for others. By monitoring their own health, students learn to take personal responsibility for their well-being, while also playing their part in safeguarding the health of those around them. As such, all SKLites are reminded to bring their Oral Digital Thermometer (ODT) in good working condition each time they return to school.

Safety Matters

As part of our commitment to ensuring the safety of every SKLite, our school conducts lockdown drills and fire evacuation drills to prepare our students to respond calmly and swiftly in the event of an emergency. These drills are essential as these would help to build familiarity and confidence in SKLites so that they

know exactly what to do when it matters most. Just as we care for ourselves and one another in our daily routines, these drills reinforce the importance of looking out for each other during critical situations.

We will be conducting these drills in Term 3. We seek your support in speaking with your child / ward about the importance of taking these drills seriously, so that together, we can ensure the safety and well-being of our entire school community.

5. School Telephone Facilities

We would like to inform you that the service provider for the public payphones in the school canteen will **cease operations with effect from Term 3**. Students who need to contact their parents/guardians during school hours may do so through the telephone at the General Office.

This arrangement ensures that students continue to have access to communication support when necessary, during school hours. We will also take the opportunity to guide our SKLites on the appropriate and responsible use of the telephone, and to contact parents/guardians **only when necessary**. We seek your support in reminding your child/ward of this expectation.

6. School-based Assessments

As we continue into the new school term, the school will continue to use assessments purposefully to monitor and support our students' learning progress. Through a learner-centered and balanced approach to assessment, teachers will gather insights on students' understanding, identify areas requiring further support, and provide timely feedback to help students improve and grow.

In Term 3, the assessment approach will be as follows:

- **Primary 1 and Primary 2:** Non-weighted Holistic Assessments will continue.
- **Primary 3 to Primary 5:** Students will continue with Weighted Assessments in Term 3, followed by the End-of-Year Assessment in Term 4.
- **Primary 6:** Students will engage in subject practices, sit for the Preliminary Examination at the end of Term 3, and take the PSLE in Term 4.

Students who are absent for an assessment must submit a Medical Certificate (MC) that covers the period of absence. A letter from parents will not be accepted for absences during assessments.

If a student is absent without an MC, the student will receive **0 marks** for that assessment component.
