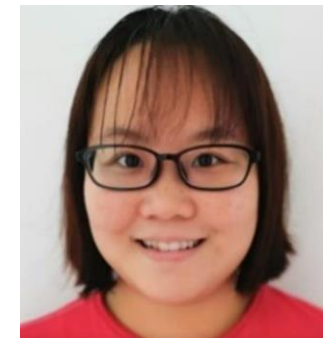

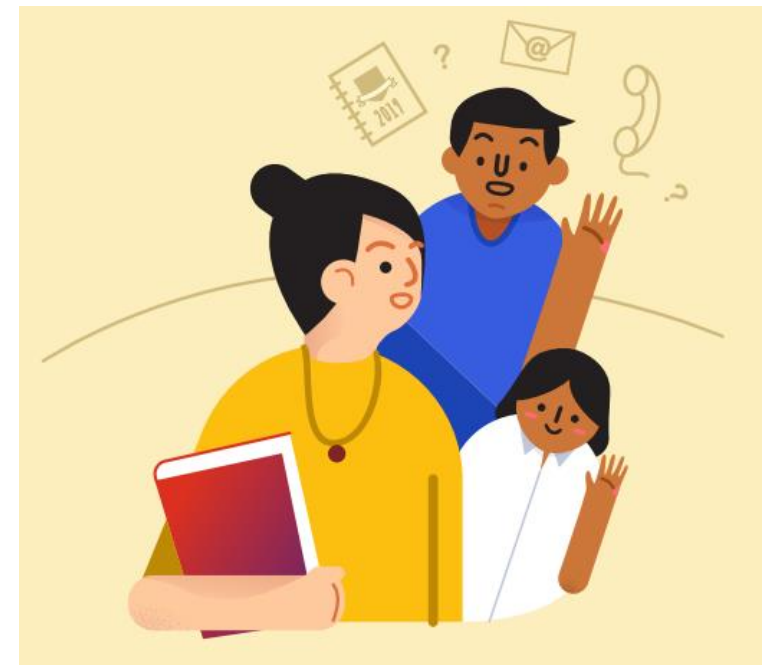

Learning and growing

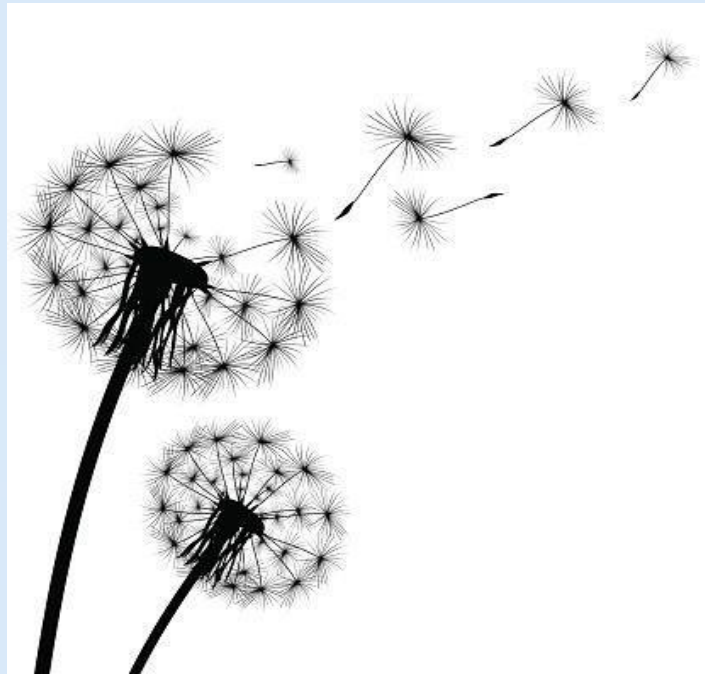
We are open to new ideas and are bold without being reckless or disrespectful. We inspire, challenge and support one another to be our best and sustain our effort.

- And the invaluable partnership and connection with the school's teachers in activities such as the Soccer Clinics.

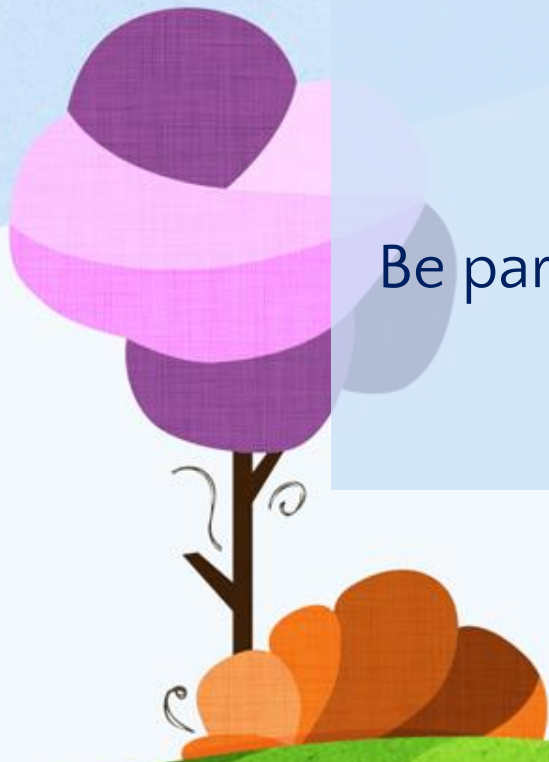

ATTIRE

On the first day of school



Hair must be kept short and neat

Name tags	To be purchased from the school bookshop Must be ironed onto each uniform and PE shirt
School socks	Must be black with SKPS printed on them
School shoes	Must be all black

For Girls

Hair accessories	Must be black
Long hair	Tied neatly in a ponytail or two plaits
Long fringe	Clipped up / use a hairband or cut short above eyebrows
Earrings	Small ear studs (black, gold, silver only)

P1 students can enter school via Gate 3A (back gate) from 3 Jan onwards.

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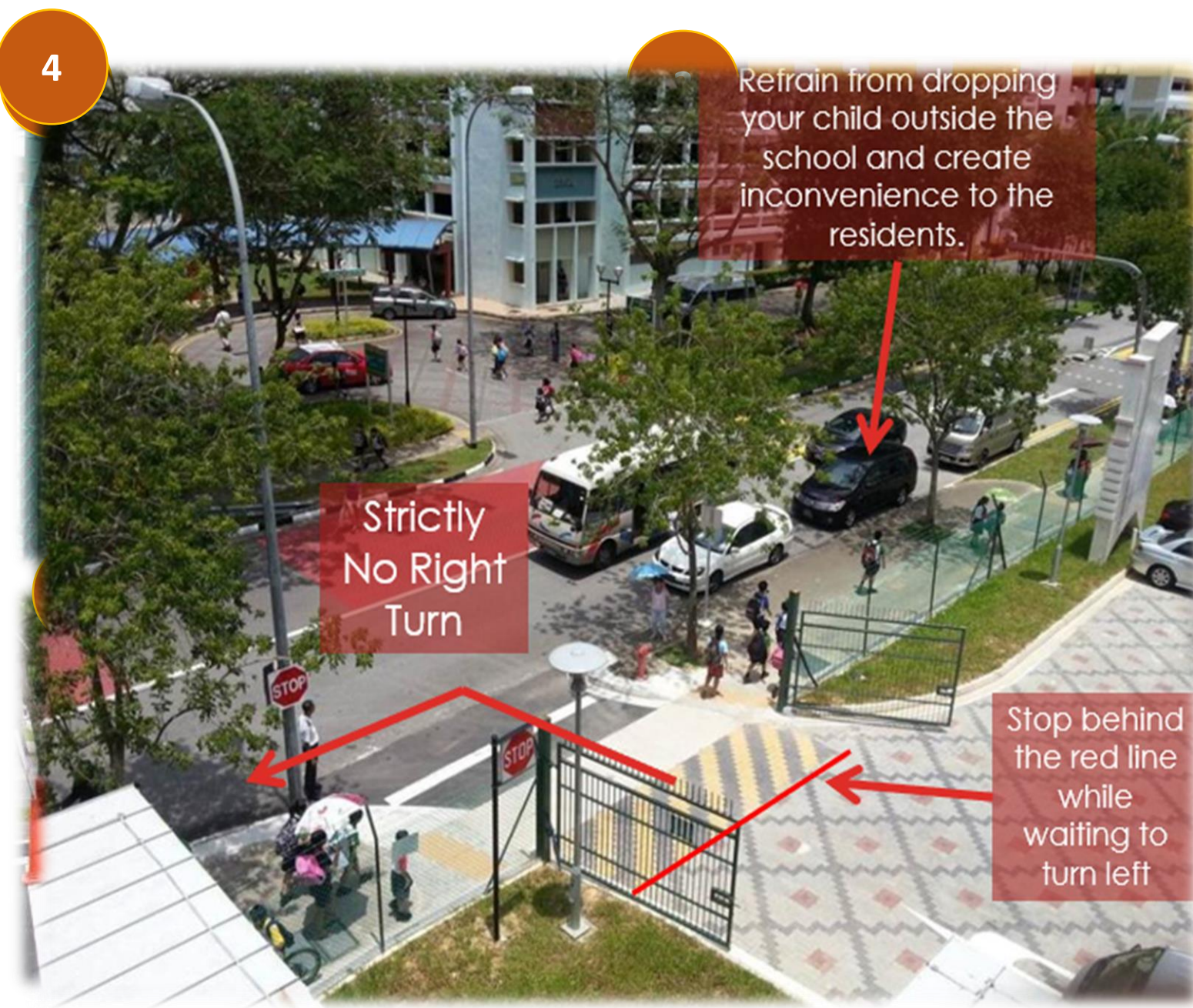

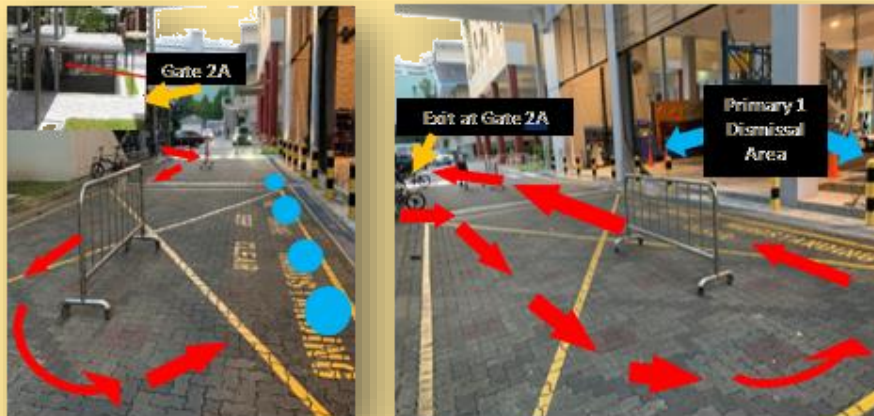


School dismissal from basketball court

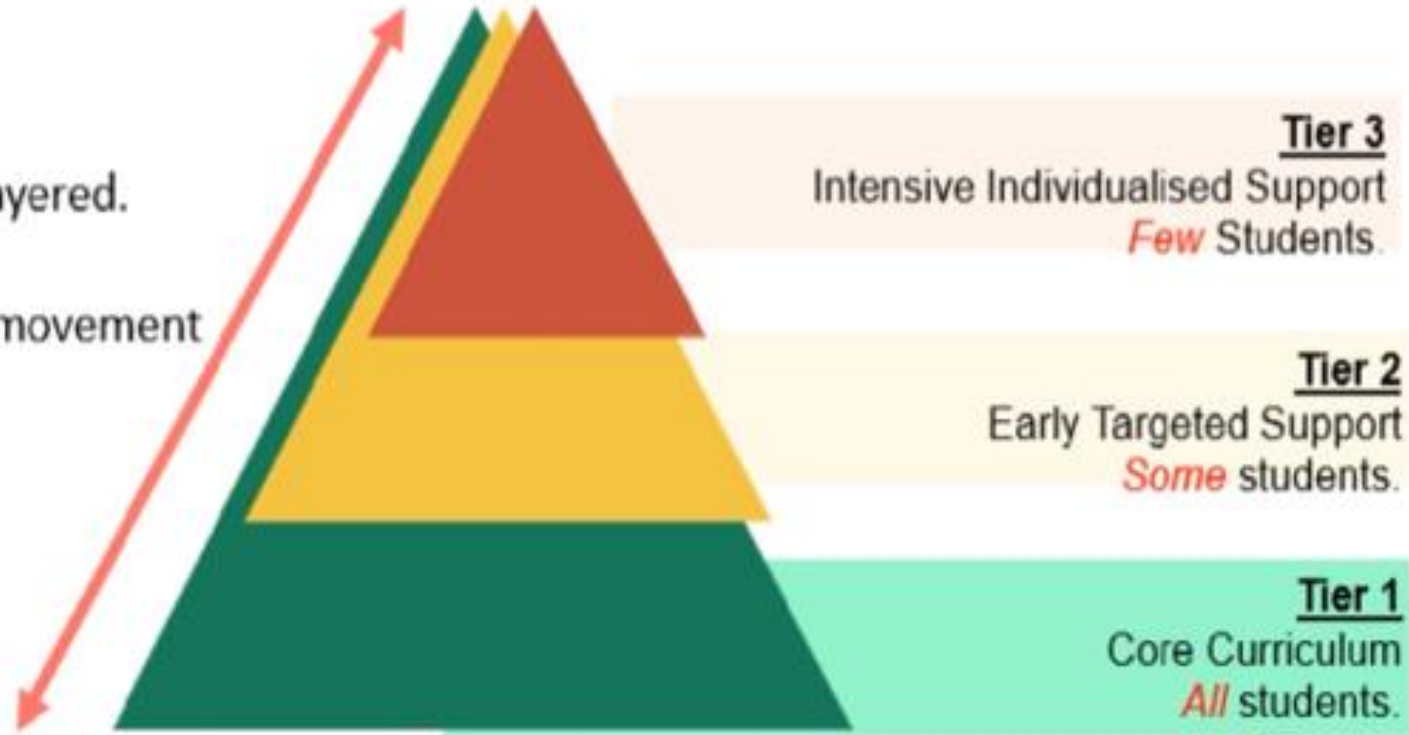
- 10-minute Snack Break

There can be fluidity of movement across tiers.

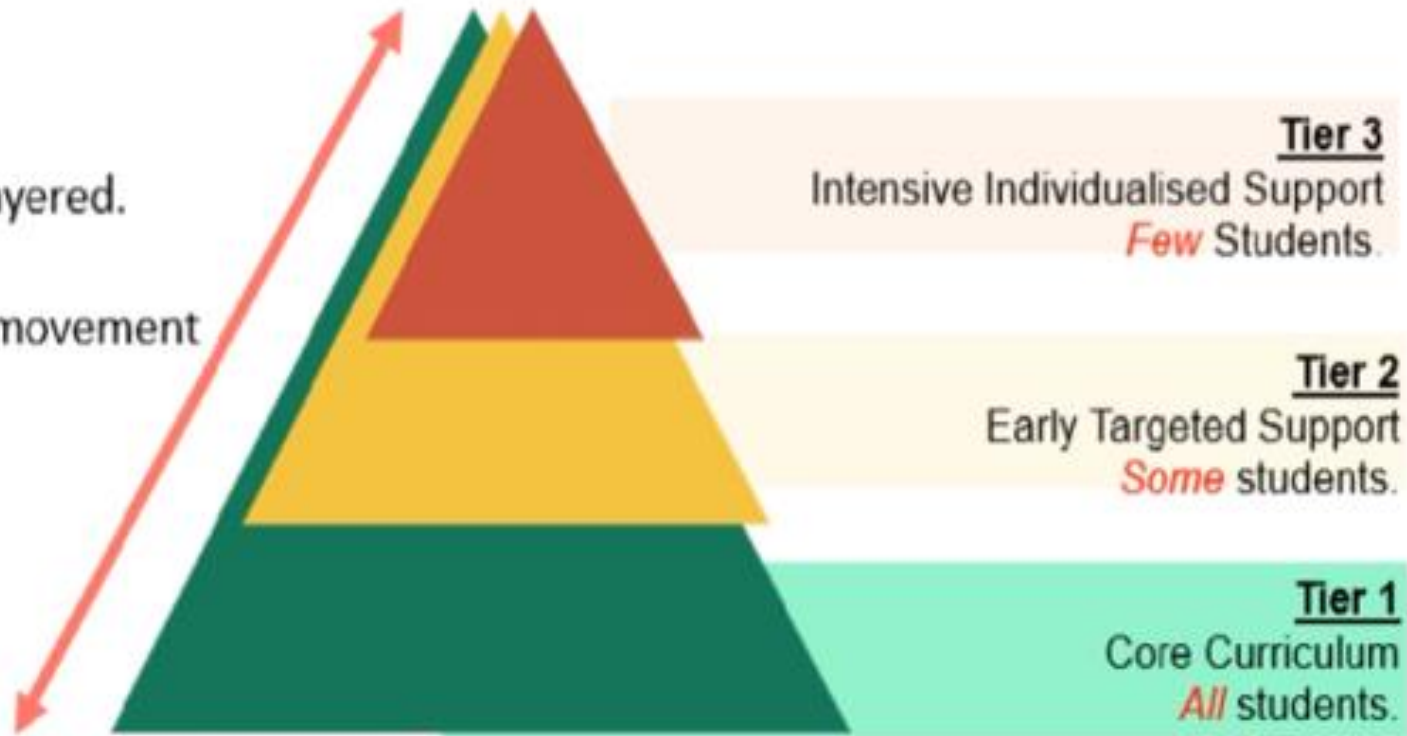

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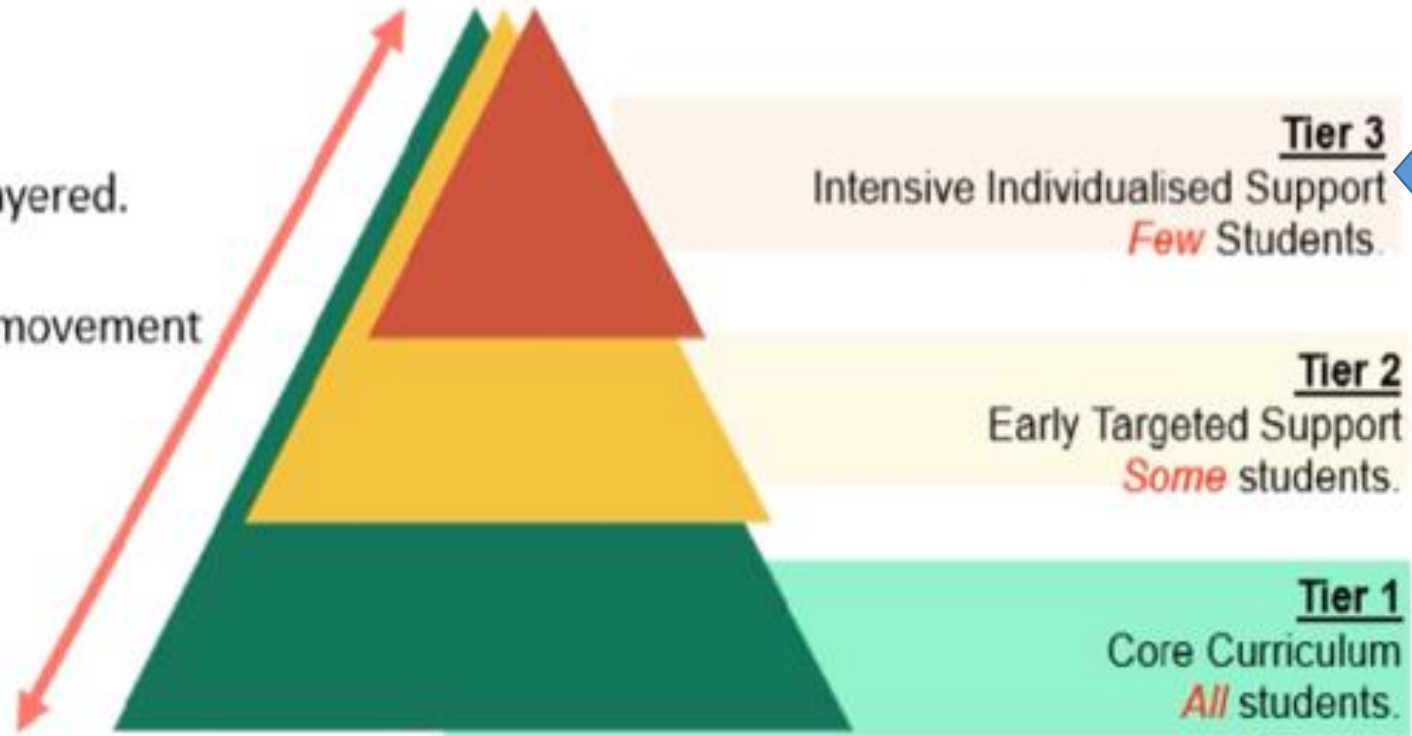
